

**223-AG-1. USE OF BICYCLES/MOTOR VEHICLES
Administrative Guideline**

**Rules and Guidelines Interpreting Board Policy
of Use of Bicycles/Motor Vehicles (223)**

- I. High school students, upon receipt of approval from the principal, shall have the privilege of driving to school in their own vehicles.
- II. Students must park their cars in the parking areas designated for students, as listed in the student handbook. There will be no loitering in the parking lot or sitting in parked cars prior to school or during school hours. Students are to enter immediately upon their arrival.
- III. Student drivers must show evidence of a valid Pennsylvania license and no-fault insurance coverage.
- IV. Student drivers must submit a permission form signed by their parent/guardian to the principal's office.
- V. All vehicles must be registered in the principal's office as to make, model and license number.
- VI. A permit sticker, issued by the principal's office, must be displayed on the rear view mirror of the vehicle.
- VII. All vehicles must be driven only on roadways provided and all vehicles must be parked in designated areas.
- VIII. Nonregistered vehicles will be towed from school property at the owner's expense.
- IX. Any violations of this policy or the provisions under which approval to drive is granted will result in revoking of driver privileges.
- X. Reckless driving and drag racing in the parking area are major offenses and cannot be tolerated. The principal must clear any exceptions to the above guidelines.
